Physical description of classrooms

The classrooms assigned to Appalachian courses most often are on the second level of Hayes Hall, rooms 410, 411, and 412. These rooms are near the office of the Arts & Sciences Division, where faculty can get supplies, use the copier, and get assistance if needed. The rooms have adult furniture that can be configured to meet various instructional strategies and student activities (see images below).

Space usage, administrative support and technical support are governed by the Appalachian Learning Alliance Agreement. Financial considerations are governed by the UNC-NCCCS Space Usage Agreement.

Additional campus resources near Hayes Hall include a computer lab available for student use from 8:00 AM - 8:50 PM, Monday through Thursday in room 252 Thompson Hall; the Absher Bookstore, open until 6:45 PM with supplies and food items for sale; the Learning Resources Center/Pardue Library in Alumni Hall, and the ECMD Student Commons area in Alumni Hall. WCC Security has officers on duty throughout the day and evening; security officers will provide an escort for students returning to parking areas at night, when requested, as well as assist with any emergencies or safety concerns. For general assistance, Appalachian faculty and staff may contact the Student Services office, which is staffed each evening until 7:00 PM.

Technology in Rooms 410, 411, 412 and Other Hayes Hall Classrooms

Any classroom assigned to Appalachian State University programs would have the following equipment (see images below):

- Ceiling-mounted digital projector that supports multiple devices
- ELMO document camera
- Mobile cart with 16 laptops and printer (two carts available)

- Wireless internet access for instructors and students
